## WAHA Memorials

Within the past few weeks, the Wisconsin Arabian Horse Association has suffered the deaths of three members.

Debbie Scott was the wife of long-time WAHA member Bill Scott, who served several years as a Regional delegate from WAHA. During the past few years of their courtship and marriage, Debbie also became active in WAHA and devoted several hours a year to working at WAHA events. She was one of the first to receive paybacks from the new WAHA Volunteer Rewards program. Debbie died Christmas day 2008 after a long battle with cancer. The family asked for memorials to go

to their parish, St. Mary's Episcopal Church, P. O. Box 126, Dousman, WI 53118.

On March 16, John White of Woodstock, IL, also succumbed to cancer. He was an accomplished young trainer and an avid supporter of WAHA shows for many years. He leaves his wife, Lisa Jo, and two young sons, Zach and Rex. An educational fund has been established for the boys at Zach & Rex White Education Fund, McHenry Savings Bank, 353 Bank Drive, McHenry, IL 60050.

Also on March 16, Liz Bevry passed away after a long struggle with vasculitis. She and her

husband, Ken, Sr., loved raising and showing horses for over 40 years, and they were also very active WAHA members and gracious hosts for WAHA events at their Franksville farm. Their son Ken, Jr. was also an avid

youth exhibitor and a familiar figure at WAHA shows. In lieu of flowers, the family suggested memorials to C.N.S.V. Vasculitis Foundation, P.O. Box 28660 Kansas City, MO. 64188.

All 4-H and FFA members are encouraged to sign their Arabian or Half-Arabian up this NEW award sponsored by WAHA. In order to be eligible for the award 4-H and FFA members must compete with a registered Arabian or Half-Arabian at any of the three events. Performance and equitation classes count towards the award. The overall high point award will be recognized at the WAHA

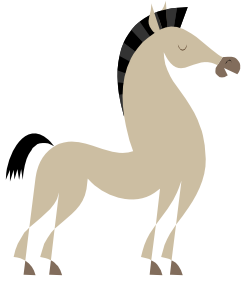
