## Volunteer Rewards Program

In 2007, the WAHA Board established the Volunteer Rewards Program to say "Thank you!" to WAHA members who donate their time to help at our shows, clinics, the Midwest Horse Fair, and other programs like TAIL. Kudos to Jackie Johnson for suggesting this program and for volunteering to be the secretary who receives reporting forms and keeps track of members' points. At the end of the year she and Treasurer Bev Cole work together to calculate paybacks.

To earn points, you must be a WAHA member, and all

categories of WAHA membership (except for WAHA Board members) are eligible: adults, associates, and youth. A two-hour block is worth one point, and you must work at least two hours straight for the time to count. Finally, you must record your time on the Rewards reporting form, have it signed by the person in charge of the event you worked at, and mail it to the Rewards Secretary within 15 days after the end of the event. Rewards checks are distributed at the Annual Meeting (or mailed after that).

In 2007 and 2008 we budgeted \$1,000 for Volunteer rewards. In 2007 each point (two hour segment) was worth \$5.73, and 35 WAHA members received checks, while in 2008 a point was worth \$7.46, and 22 recipients shared the pot. For the second year in a row, Rachel Bell took home the largest check and was named Volunteer of the Year!

For 2009, we've increased the budget to \$1,200, and we hope that more WAHA members will participate! Besides a nice financial reward, volunteering is just

plain fun. It provides a chance to get to know other WAHA members and to learn more about how things like our shows, clinics, TAIL program, and the Midwest Horse Fair work. Wouldn't you like to sign up? And perhaps a friend or family member would like to work with you too!

The young lady we are honoring here today has

certainly met and exceeded those requirements.

While in high school, Kelly served as the High School Class Treasurer, Vice President, and President from 2001 to 2003. She also served as the Softball Team Captain. All of this while maintaining a 4.0 average. Kelly is now attending the Marquette University School of Dentistry in Milwaukee and maintaining a better than 3.9 GPA.

Kelly Jones has been a very active youth member of the WAHA club and served as the WAHA Youth vice-president, secretary and reporter. She also served as a Region 10 Vice Director and Youth Director, as well as a delegate to the Arabian

Horse Youth Association National Convention. She has competed as a member of the Region 10 Judging Team, helping the team achieve Top Ten awards. Kelly also achieved a Reserve National Championship and Top Ten placings at the US National Championship Arabian and Half-Arabian Horse Show.

## Region 10 Ambassador Award WAHA Recipient - Sandhill Fair Lady Owned by Allison Goetz

The WAHA/Region 10 Ambassador Award was established to honor those Purebred Arabians and Half-Arabians that demonstrate the loyalty and trustworthiness that highlight the Arabian breed. This special horse should have demonstrated the versatility of the breed in an area that is unique and exhibit outstanding performance and/or service when measured against other breeds. The horse that we are honoring this year has done all that and more. Sandhill Fair Lady started her long career as a show horse competing in Dressage, Show Hack, Hunter Pleasure and Country Pleasure. She received Region 10 Championships in Dressage, Hunter Pleasure and Show Hack.

Her owner Allison Goetz, states she also showed her at local open shows, in lead line with her niece and at

the Lodi Fair. She started teaching "Lady" to jump and took her to local schooling shows as well as the "Mane Event Show" series. "Lady" competed successfully in Hunter over Fences, Hunter on the Flat and Hunt Seat Equitation against all breeds at open Hunter shows. At Thistle Downs "Lady" and Allison won at training level dressage against some very tough competitors of all breeds and also placed well in the combined event.

In 1997, Allison became interested in distance riding with "Lady", especially competitive trail. Allison states that she had been riding "Lady" on trail rides and riding the roads where she lived and "Lady" loved it. Allison entered her first ride and "Lady" placed third in a large group of seasoned horses to Allison's delight. Also, in 1997, Allison met her future husband; Gary and

"Lady" taught him to ride. "Lady" was so sensible on the road with traffic and on the trail that Allison trusted them together.

Allison continued to compete in Competitive Trail with "Lady" in 1999 and 2000 winning often and getting scores in the 390's out of 400. She continued going to saddle club rides with "Lady" and giving "horsey rides" to her nieces, nephews, co-workers grandchildren and assorted beginners. "Lady" also competed in the Dusty Trails Gymkhana and placed well in such classes as barrels, poles, plug race, jumping figure 8 and flag race.

2001 was a very successful year for Allison and "Lady". They started the year with the Glacier Trails Ride with a perfect 400 score!! That is virtually unheard of! In June, they went to the Region 10 Championship

Ride in southeast Minnesota and won it with a score of 99 out of 100!! And this was on a 50 Mile Ride!! Also, that year they participated in the US National Competitive Ride at Jubilee Forest in Illinois and placed third, winning a National Top Ten! Allison states this was more that she could have ever dreamed! Allison states that she has continued to compete and

also ride "Lady" for pleasure. She often lets friends and beginners ride "Lady". She has also started to lead Novice Rides for new distance riders as "Lady's" calm attitude and experience helps new horses settle down and learn to enjoy the rides. Allison and Gary have also taken "Lady" and their other horse on some of their vacations that included going to South

Dakota and Mount Rushmore. This talented and beautiful mare also produced a foal in 2004 that Allison named Shadow Trax.

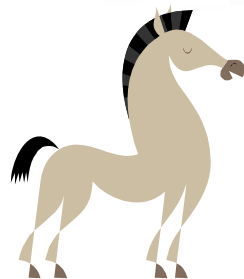

For many years, WAHA has been looking at ways to improve participation in our small Futurity/Maturity Program. After much discussion, we have come up with what we hope is a popular, productive new idea!!

### What's Happening??

The WAHA Board of Directors has voted to replace the current WAHA Futurity/Maturity program with equivalent halter and performance Jackpot classes at the August show. For example, the former PB Western Pleasure 5 & Under Futurity class will be replaced with a PB Western Pleasure Jr. Horse WAHA Member Jackpot class. The classes will remain Open, so anyone can show the horse, as long as one owner is a full voting WAHA member, just as the Futurity/Maturity required. In addition, each performance division will have a WAHA Member Amateur Jackpot class.



**NEW**

### Advantages to this change include:

-All of your former Futurity/Maturity classes will now be **WAHA Member Jackpot** classes instead. This applies to both the former futurity/maturity halter and performance classes! We are not eliminating any classes!

-**Costs less to participate** for horses that may not have been in the program previously!

-**No early nominations are necessary!** No need to enter until the show, allowing you to wait and see how great your horse is coming along!

-**Only \$40 to enter per class**, but no yearly nomination fees or paperwork!

-**Less paperwork and less confusion** for everyone!

### How will this work??

For the 2009 show season, the WAHA August show will continue the Amateur Jackpot classes that were so popular in 2008, however, they will now be WAHA member jackpot classes. In addition, the futurity/maturity classes will be replaced with the WAHA Member Open Jackpot classes, giving Amateur exhibitors two chances to show for big paybacks. For all WAHA Member Jackpot classes, at least one owner must be a full, voting member of WAHA (same as the current futurity program).

Participants do not need to enroll in this program in advance. Once you get your prize list for the August show, you can choose to do pre-entries, or sign up at the show. **There is no post-entry fee for the WAHA Member Jackpot classes.**

### How does the payback work??

Each Jackpot class will cost \$40 per horse to enter, with no additional cost for post entry. Each individual WAHA Member Jackpot class will pay back money according to the chart below. "Allocated Money" is all entry fees minus trophy and ribbon expenses for that class. Paybacks will be made through 4<sup>th</sup> place only.

One (1) horse: 100% of allocated money

Two (2) horses: 60%, 40% of allocated money

Three (3) horses: 50%, 30%, 20% of allocated money

Four (4) horses: 40%, 30%, 20%, 10% of allocated money

Payback checks will be mailed out to the recorded owner of a horse as soon as possible after the show ends.
